PLEASE NOTE:

- Organizations that would like to exhibit that are not a boutique MN makers/artist, or pet product company are welcome to participate as exhibiting sponsors. See sponsorship packet for benefits, details, and levels.
- The distinction between categories is at the discretion of the event organizer team. The intention is to maintain an accessible event for nonprofits and boutique product companies while highlighting community leadership of larger and more established brands.
- Application for participation does not guarantee event entry.
- Electrical power is not provided. Getting power from local buildings is prohibited and any generator usage must be approved prior to event.
- Event fee includes physical space reservation only. All tents, fixtures, and product, must be brought in.
- Exhibitor's setup must remain completely within allocated space.
- Exhibitor fees are due 10 days prior to event or reservation may be canceled.
- Exhibitor space is assigned near event time. Priority is given based on early payment and other factors.
- Exhibitor must be in-place prior to event open and must remain open until event end. No late setup or early tear down.
- All setup/product must be delivered and carried from edge of grounds unless other arrangements are made in advance. Plan to bring a cart or wagon!
- Exhibitors, staff, and volunteers should park a minimum of (3) blocks from event grounds leaving immediate parking for guests and those with accessibility needs.
- Event fees are non-refundable, even in the event of cancellation.
- Appropriate images and content must be submitted to and approved by LHwoofstock organizers to be featured on the event website.
- All tents MUST be properly weighted in case of wind or weather.
- Any dogs brought onto grounds by exhibitors and guests must be on-leash or properly restrained and in the full control of their owners.
- If you see a guest (human OR dog) not behaving in a safe or appropriate manor, please intervene OR immediately seek the attention of staff, security, or volunteers.
- Linden Hills Woofstock is not responsible for any loss, damage, or personal injury associated with the participation of the community festival.
